- **Roger Powell**, formerly of Todd Rundgren's Utopia, has released a solo disc called "Fossil Poets" with studio support from a pair of Milwaukee vets, **Greg Koch** and **Gary Tanin**. Koch plays guitar and bass on the Inner Knot release, and Tanin plays synthesizer and helps with production and arrangements. Both musicians also contributed their songwriting talents to the project.

- Two former Milwaukee musicians were honored recently posthumously with markers on Nashville's Music City Walk of Fame. They are former Milwaukee Symphony conductor **Kenneth Schermerhorn** and songwriting great **Felice Bryant**, who was honored along with her late husband, **Boudleaux Bryant**.

Schermerhorn was conductor of the Nashville Symphony after leaving Milwaukee. Felice Bryant was a Milwaukee native and met her husband while working in a downtown hotel. Together they were among Nashville's most successful songwriting teams and penned "Rocky Top" plus many of the Everly Brothers' big hits. The walk is located in Hall of Fame Park in downtown Nashville.

Living inductees into the Walk of Fame were Reba McEntire, Ronnie Milsap and the Fisk Jubilee Singers.
